THE MYSTERY IN THE OLD ATTIC

Not from the Bakery Window!

Henry's favorite blueberry muffins come straight from your oven. Ask an adult to help you make them, though!

You will need: 2 cups flour, 4 teaspoons baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/4 cup sugar, 1 egg beaten, 1/4 cup of melted margarine, 1 cup milk, 1 cup blueberries (if you don't like blueberries, try raisins instead).

Here's what you do:

- 1. Ask an adult to preheat your oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. Mix the dry ingredients together in one bowl. Mix the wet ingredients in another bowl.
- 3. Use a mixing spoon to combine the ingredients in the two bowls. Do not mix the ingredients for too long (there should be lumps in the batter).
- 4. Stir in the blueberries.
- 5. Fill greased muffin tins 3/4 full with the muffin batter.
- 6. Ask an adult to put the muffins in the oven and bake for 25 minutes.
- 7. After the 25 minutes, ask the adult to take the muffins out of the oven. Wait for the muffins to cool.

Makes 12-15 muffins
