The Aldens love to cook. That's a good thing, because they also love to eat! Here are two of their favorite holiday recipes.

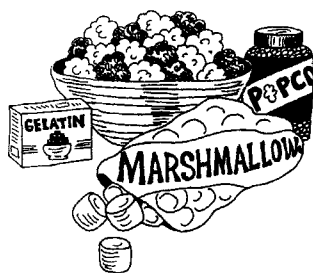
Deck the Halls Popcorn Balls

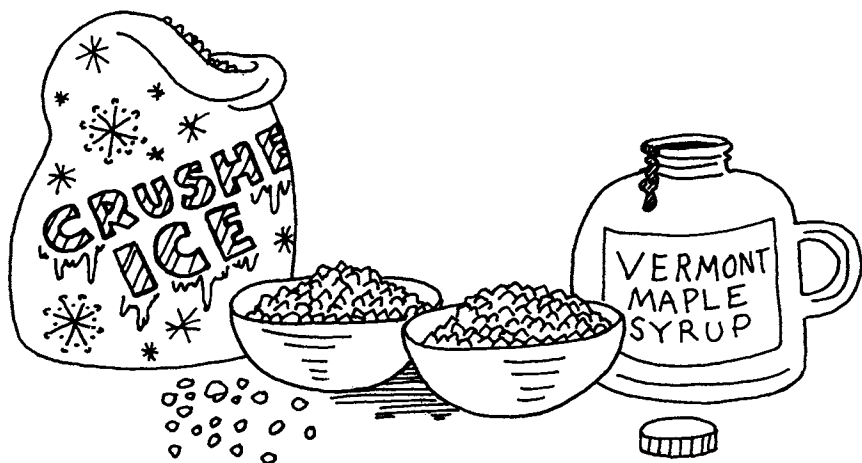
You will need:

5 tablespoons butter or margarine
3 cups miniature marshmallows
3 tablespoons powdered lime gelatin and powdered cherry or raspberry gelatin
3 quarts unsalted popcorn

Here's what you do:

1. Ask a grown-up to melt the butter in a saucepan.
 2. Mix in the marshmallows.
 3. Blend in the powdered lime gelatin.
 4. Pour the whole mixture over the popcorn. Use your hands to make popcorn balls.
- To make red popcorn balls, follow the same recipe using the cherry or raspberry powdered gelatin.





Maple Ice

You will need:

1 cup finely crushed ice
maple syrup
2 bowls

Here's what you do:

1. Divide the ice evenly between the two bowls.
2. Pour maple syrup over the ice in each bowl. Make sure all of the ice is covered in maple syrup.
